Parish Council met with Village War Memorial Hall Committee to update risk assessments and conditions of use for Bailey field.

The presence of some flagstones on the field has made maintenance with a tractor impossible. Clerk to include this area in PC gardening contract for maintenance by strimming.

## 16 | Any other business

- **a. Footpath:** From the end of Smithy row overgrown and muddy. SB will investigate acquiring some hardcore/grit and strimming to clear the path.#
- **b. Bailey Arms.** SB contacted the brewery and received an email reply stating that the Bailey Arms is likely to be advertised for sale in due course.
- c. Approval of requests for paint for little library and a parishioner gift.
- d. Parking on the bend opposite the shireburn. It was double parked here on 20.10.24 blocking the pathway and creating a blind single carriage. Community police were contacted who said that it was poor decision making on the part of the drivers. There are no parking restriction so they could not enforce. They advised contacting LCC re asking for double yellow lines on one side of the carriageway. Clerk to action.
